

Saint Rosa chapel


You'll find the Sint Rosa chapel on top of the Kollenberg. It is a small building with a large and rich history. The chapel was built in 1675 in honour of Saint Rosa, the patron saint of Sittard. In 1668 a dysentery epidemic broke out in Sittard, claiming many victims. By the intercession of Latin American Saint Rosa, the contagious disease ceased.

The city council promised to hold a procession every year, on the last Sunday of August, from St. Michael's Church (at Markt Sittard) to a chapel built in honour of St. Rosa. Sittard has kept this promise: since 1675 this famous thanksgiving procession takes place every year.





The Maanplein is part of the Maankwartier project. The design is by artist Michel Huisman. Huisman developed a new urban area in Heerlen. It is a place where the station, shops, cafes, hotels, offices and housing come together.

The atmosphere is reminiscent of an old Mediterranean industrial area. It is intended as a transit route for people to and from the station and the old town. It has been developed and furnished in such a way that passers-by are invited here to relax and meet each other.
